This is to inform all students of the 5-Year B.A. LL.B. Course and 3-Year LL.B. Course that, as per the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008 and Gauhati University Regulations regarding Internship, the following instructions shall be strictly followed by students intending to pursue internship:

1. Each registered student shall complete a minimum of 12 weeks of internship in the case of the 3-Year LL.B. Course and 20 weeks of internship in the case of the 5-Year B.A. LL.B. Course.
2. A student shall be allowed to undertake internship for a maximum period of 15 days during the semester break in a given semester. This shall amount to a total of 4 weeks of internship in an academic year.
3. Every student shall maintain an Internship Diary, which shall be evaluated by the Internship Guide as well as by a Core Faculty Member. The same shall be assessed in the final semester of the course under the Fourth Clinical Course, as stipulated in Schedule II of the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008.
4. The recommended institutions/organizations/bodies for internship in the respective semesters are attached herewith as Annexure I (for the 3 Year LL.B. Course) and Annexure II (for the 5 Year B.A.LL.B. Course). Students may opt to undertake internship in institutions/organizations/bodies other than those recommended, subject to obtaining prior approval from the Principal.
5. Every student undertaking an internship shall submit geo-tagged photographs captured on the first and the last day of the internship at the respective institution/organization/body. The photographs shall include the concerned supervising authority, advocate, officer, or mentor under whose supervision the internship has been completed,

All students are advised to carefully comply with the above requirements and ensure timely completion of their internship obligations in accordance with the applicable rules and guidelines.
